Rules and Guidelines

»All students of "IESO Tomás de la Fuente Jurado" (from 1st to 4th) may take part in the competition.

»Contestants must build a life size dummy of Guy Fawkes. Students can make their "Guy" by their own or with one partner.

»Materials, such as paper, straw, etc can be used to create the "Guy". No dangerous materials are allowed.

» Students should seek adult permission to use all clothing.

»Any effigy unsuitable due to its design / construction / representation will be disqualified and disposed of without reference back to the

contestant. All the "Guys" must be built in good taste and have to be appropriate for all ages.

»All "Guys" must be with the promoters on November 4th no later than 8:30 a.m.

»All "Guys" should be accompanied by the students' name and class.

»All "Guys" will be displayed at school from 4th November to 8th November.

»A committee comprising of 4 to 6 teachers will vote on their favourite "Guy". The "Guy" that receives the most votes will be the winner. The decision of the judges is final in every situation and no correspondence will be entered into.

»On 8th November, the jury will notify the winner.

»The promoters do not accept responsibilities for late or lost entries.

»The promoters reserve the right to cancel the competition at any stage.

»The prize that may be awarded to the eligible winner(s) is not transferable, redeemable for cash or exchangeable for any other prize. All prizes must be redeemed within 10 days of the contest

end date unless otherwise stated in the contest's official rules.

»If the quality of the entries is not appropriate, the prize may be "not awarded".

»It is the responsibility of entrants to keep themselves informed as to any updates of these rules, and they acknowledge that failure to comply with these rules could lead to their disqualification without reasons being given or opportunity for challenge.

»The contestants must consent to a photograph to be used for future advertising material.
